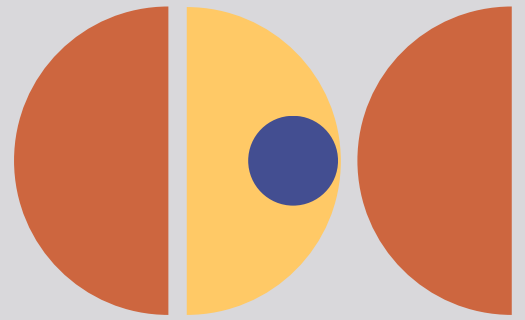
Community Reading Room Project

MARCH 2025. STATUS OF READING ROOM. We reopened the community reading room project on 21 January 2023 in the premises of our Registered Office in Maharani Avenue, Vadavalli, Coimbatore after we closed our Nekarara Colony Community reading room in Bangalore. As on March 2025, we have an **online repository** of over **1473 books** including Level Based Reading Books from Pratham and a variety of Horror, Comics out of which about **340+ books** are Academic Law Books or guides .

In September 2023, LONG LENDING INITIATIVE, we were able to provide around 49 books and guides to 17+ students of the Government Law Collge, Coimbatore on **Long Lending Initiate** of the Payanmaram Reading Room. Two Long Lending drives have happened this Financial Year - one in July/August 2024 and another in February/March 2025. In this February-March 2025 initiative, we have reached about 50 students who are given books until end of semester. Proof of income was used to shortlist the applications.



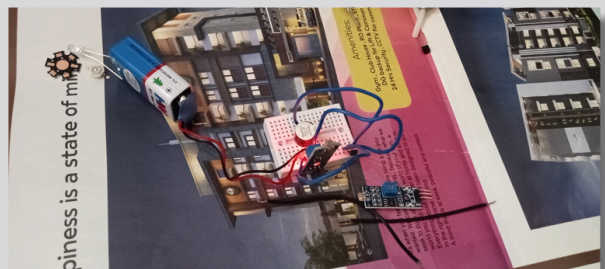
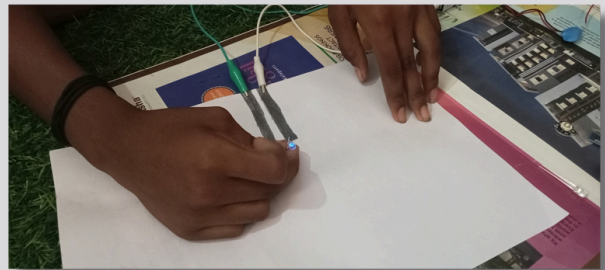
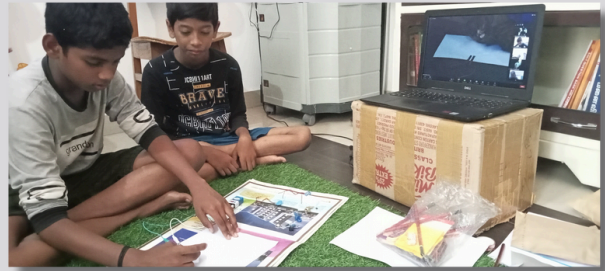

Two Year Plan → *Priority Wise*

RAISING FUNDS, GRANTS & SPONSORSHIPS. Going further will require more funds to pay Honorariums and meet event expenses or to buy the material support we intend to offer in the focus areas and depending on the same we can engage people to the work and implement project ideas in these heads.

STREAMLINING ADMINISTRATIVE WORK. In addition to the social media accounts we maintain, we could work on updating the annual reports and statistics on a regular basis.

DISABLED STUDENTS. Presently we are working with a few of them and expect some useful work in that direction.

SURVEYS / PROTECTION. Our work began with Children in Need of Care and Protection in Jeedimara slum. Out of School Children Surveys help identify children in need of care and protection in time for rehabilitation and shall remain a priority.
